The Neighbourhood Watch Program is...

The Neighbourhood Watch Program is a crime prevention initiative based on communication between citizens and the authorities. The aim is to discourage and prevent crime in the neighbourhood by getting citizens to keep watch for each other. The Neighbourhood Watch Program brings collaboration as well as concerted action and helps us more effectively focus on fighting crime.



How does the program work?

The program is based on mutual assistance. You know your neighbours, their vehicles and, very often, their habits. In short, you are the person best placed to detect suspicious activity and individuals in the neighbourhood. And that is why you can help make your neighbourhood safer simply by getting to know your neighbours better.



Why get involved?

It couldn't be easier! You already know what is normal in your neighbourhood. By becoming an active member of the program and building relationships with your neighbours, keep an eye on what is happening in the area. If you notice a crime or suspicious activity in progress, you contact the police department. In this way, you not only help reduce crime, you also create a safer environment for your family.

To report an emergency, crime or suspicious activity in progress,
dial 9-1-1.

By getting involved in the program, you will help:

- Prevent crime in your neighbourhood
- Make your neighbourhood safer
- Improve the quality of life in your neighbourhood
- Build stronger ties with your neighbours and community spirit
- Increase your feeling of belonging, of being part of the community
- Develop closer relations with your Public Security Department



When you sign up for the program, your contact information will be given to Town of Mount Royal's Public Security Department. You will then be invited to attend Neighbourhood Watch Committee meetings, where you can speak with other members and share your concerns with the Public Security agents.

How do I join the program?

To become a member:

- 1 Go to www.town.mount-royal.qc.ca/public-security-services and fill out the registration form you'll find there.
- 2 The Town of Mount Royal Public Security will look over your file before registering you as a member.
- 3 You will then receive an information kit and stickers for your windows.
